 - **Email** The transition to MailRelay occurred at the end of April 2023. The service is free, but a business email had to be purchased to set up the account. Open rates are between 50% and 60% and click rates are over 4.5%. New Business

ACTION ITEMS:

- 1. Revised documents concerning the grant application and the policies and procedures for awarding grants to the Coaching Certification and ALTS certification programs were presented. The documents were accepted with no suggested revisions.
- 2. The funding for the upcoming 2023 Coaches Trainings to be held in Houston was discussed. The Treasurer presented an overview of line items in our current budget that will likely not be fully used. **ACTION ITEM:** A motion was made to increase the Coaches Certification line item budget, not to exceed an additional \$6800. (Jill) Motion approved unanimously.
- 3. The Stroke Clinic for swimmers that will be held in conjunction with the Coaches Trainings was discussed. A maximum of 36 swimmers can attend the clinic at a cost of \$50 each.
 ACTION ITEM: A motion was made to fund 100% of the stroke clinic cost for Gulf members that actually attend the clinic. (Andreas, seconded by Jill) Motion approved unanimously.
 The Gulf members who register for the clinic will be reimbursed by check after their attendance has been verified.
- **4.** Andreas suggested that the Gulf develop a program to have on-deck coaches for local meets. These coaches would be pre-assigned to attend the meet and help all swimmers, especially at the sprint lane during warm-ups. He suggested that the assigned coaches should be certified and provided a t-shirt. The idea was viewed favorably.
- 5. Nicole noted that we need one more delegate to the Annual Meeting being held Sept. 8-10, 2023, in Houston. Delegates may attend in person or virtually. Anyone interested should contact her immediately. Gulf members who are Automatic delegates are Nicole Christensen, Kris Wingenroth, Tom Boak, and Jill Gellatly. Gulf LMSC Delegates are Patrick Harrington and Alana Wilson. Currently all plan to attend in person.
- 6. Alana discussed her efforts to arrange for a swim workout at the Conroe Natatorium for the delegates at the Annual Meeting. The natatorium is about a 25 minute drive from the hotel. She has secured pool time and the Woodlands Masters have agreed to absorb the facility costs. The National Office has not been receptive. It was felt that if the Gulf agreed to cover the bus transportation costs, the USMS Executive Board might be more receptive to allowing a swim workout to be scheduled on Saturday morning. The idea of the Gulf absorbing the cost of bus transportation, if necessary, was received

- favorably. Alana and Kris will explore the cost of bus transportation. Jill and Kris will discuss the proposal further with Dawson and Peter.
